

Supply List for “Civil War Crosses” a small antique reproduction quilt

Donna O’Brien

Fabric for blocks: 15 to 20 fat eighths or fat quarters (lights, mediums and darks)
Sashing fabric: One yard
Border fabric: One yard
Neutral thread

Bring basic sewing supplies:

Sewing machine
Rotary cutter, mat and acrylic ruler
Pencil
Flat ruler for drawing
Bias square 4” or 6”
Spray sizing (not starch)
Iron and small ironing board
Light if needed
Small sewing scissors
Any sewing tools that you find helpful

To recreate the look of an antique quilt requires a scrappy look, thus the need for 15 to 20 different fabrics. I choose a pink and brown as my color way. I always add a zinger just to add interest. That’s why there is a touch of blue. You need to choose a color combination that pleases you. You may not get to the sashing and borders during our class time, but I wanted you to have the fabric requirements.

I do recommend that all fabric be **prewashed** before coming to class.
